




- *Cultural Clubs: Dance, Music, Drama, and Photography, Event clubs drew large crowds with live performances and exhibitions.

The registration counters remained busy, with enthusiastic newcomers eager to join multiple clubs. The event ended with over 2000 registrations across various clubs, a testimony to its success.
