RULES & REGULATIONS

- It is mandatory to register for the **MERAKI** to participate in any of the competition (Both Online / Offline).
- It is mandatory to fill the registration form completely along with valid payment proof, otherwise the registration will not be considered.
- One person can participate in maximum 02 competitions.

Clues in Miniature

(Theme -Forensic Science)

- Participants will have 2 hours to complete their miniature artwork on-site.
- No materials will be provided by the organizers. Maximum 3 participants per team.
- Artwork should be small-scale, adhering to the concept of miniature art.

No Flame Feast

- Participants will have a total of 2 hours to prepare and present their dish at the competition venue. Maximum 2 participants per team.
- No materials or ingredients will be provided. Participants are required to bring all necessary ingredients, utensils, and presentation items.
- No heat-based cooking methods are permitted. All dishes must be prepared without the use of fire, stove, oven, or any heating devices.

Best Crime Scene Competition

- Each team may consist of up to 10 participants.
- Teams are responsible for bringing their own materials

Innovator's Showcase

- Each poster must be within the dimensions of 4 feet in length and 3 feet in width.
- Participants are required to bring their own banner to display their poster effectively.
- It is mandatory to present handmade posters. Maximum 3 participants per team.

ForensiAct

- Each team must consist of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 participants.
- Performances must be between 6 to 10 minutes. Exceeding the maximum time limit will result in disqualification.
- The skit or drama should be related to forensic science, crime investigation, or legal scenarios. Creativity in portraying forensic concepts is encouraged.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Crime Couture

- Participants must dress up as a character related to forensics, crime, law enforcement and defence personnel or famous figures from notable crime cases.
- Participants are responsible for bringing their own costumes and props. No costumes or materials will be provided by the organizers.
- Each participant will have up to 5 minutes to present their character, including a brief introduction or act to showcase their character's role.

Rang-E- Vidence

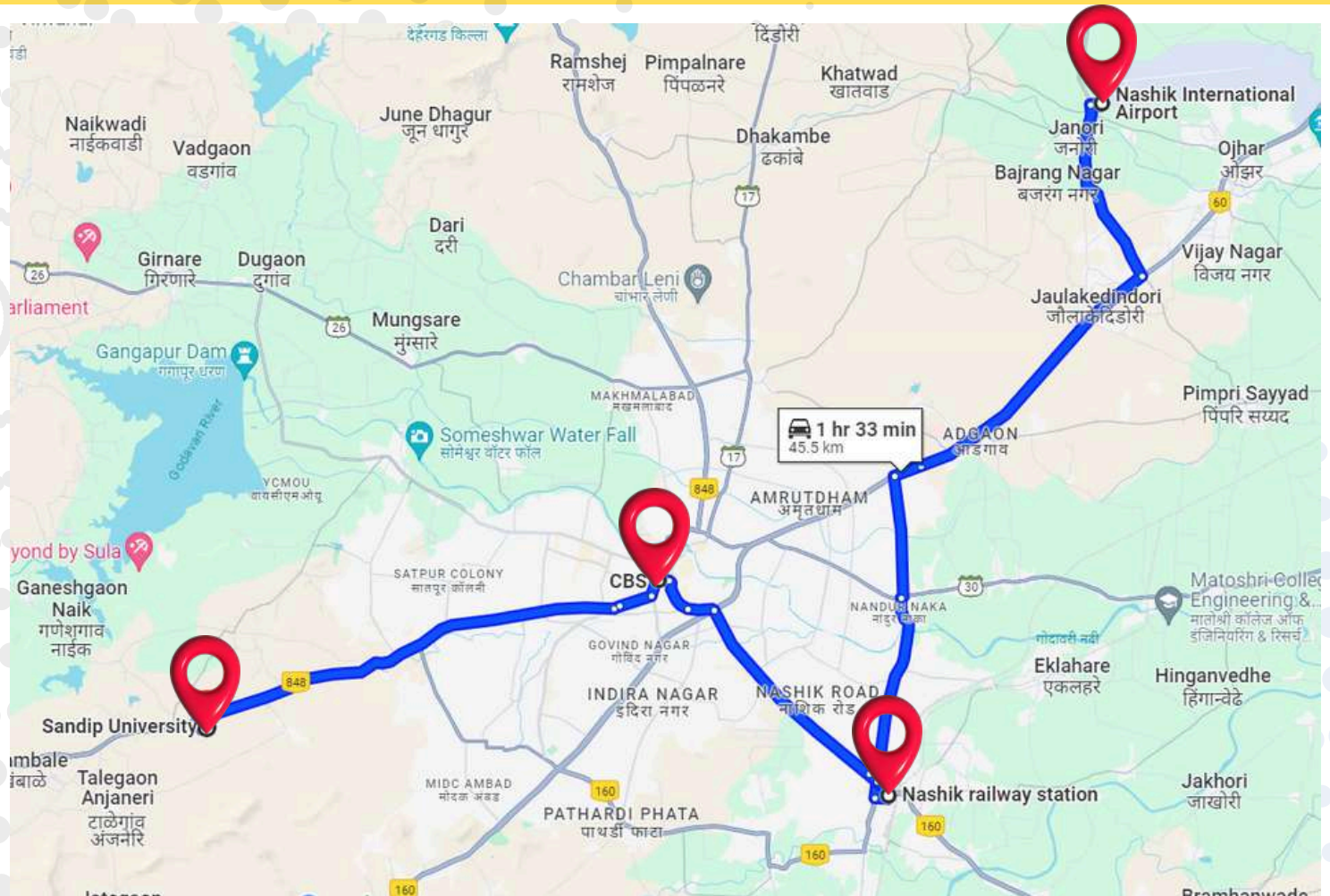
- No market rangoli powders allowed. Only natural or alternative materials (flowers, leaves, pulses, grains, soil, pebbles, paper, threads, etc.) may be used.
- Designs must creatively reflect concepts of forensic science (crime scene, evidence, fingerprints, etc.).
- Maximum 3 participants per team; complete within 2 hours.

Scene to Screen

- Only registered participants are eligible to submit a short film. The maximum allowed duration for each short film is **15 minutes**.
- The final submission date is **06th October 2025**. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Films should be related to forensic science, crime investigation, or similar topics relevant to the forensic field.
- All films must include English subtitles, regardless of the language spoken in the film.
- Students can take the help of faculties or can include faculties in short films.
- Each team may consist of up to 10 participants.
