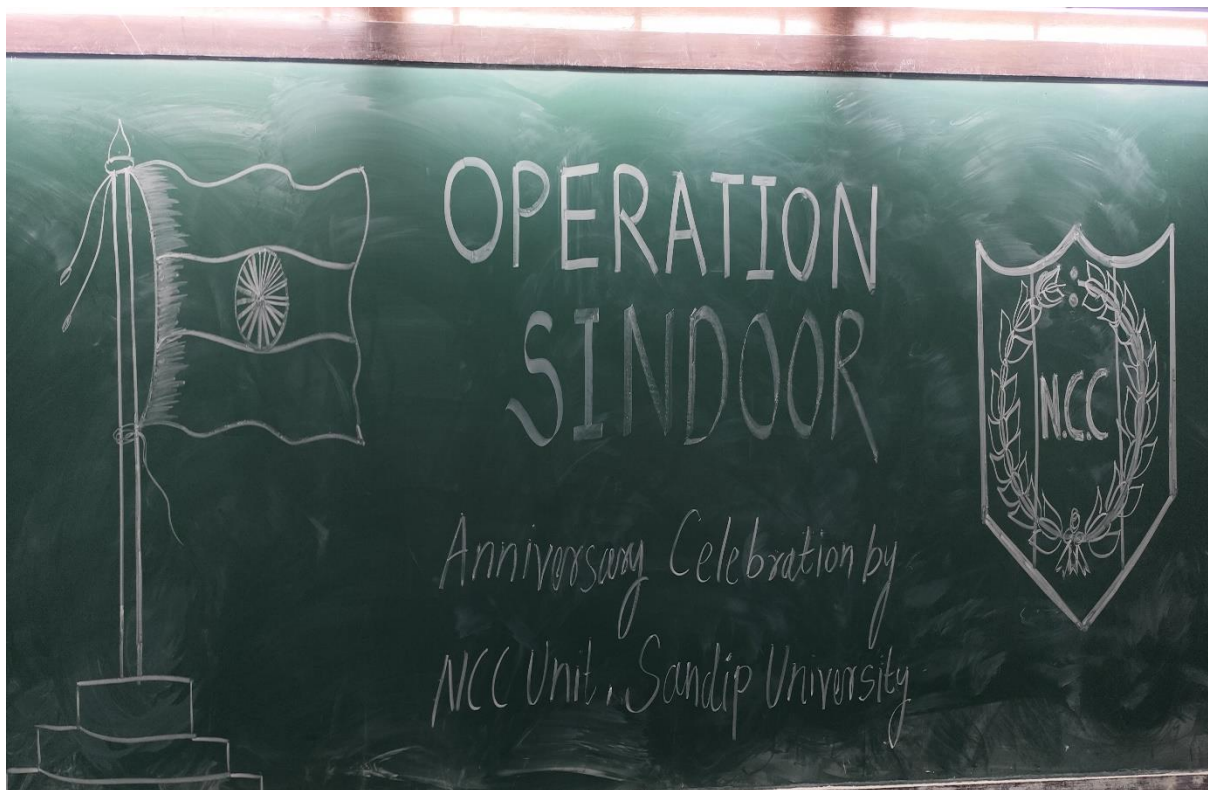
dedication towards the nation. The interaction session motivated cadets to understand the importance of NCC values such as unity, discipline, and leadership.

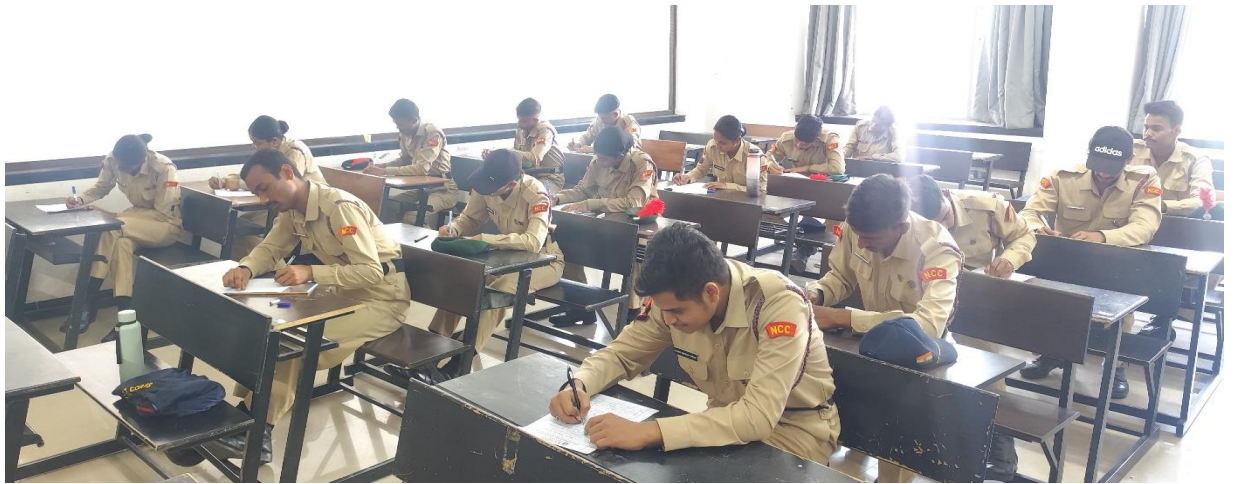
Outcome of the Event
