As prescribed by Bar Council of India, Rules of Legal Education 2008, the applicant shall have passed 10 + 2 or an examination recognised as equivalent examination there to and have obtained 45% of the total marks in case of general category, 42% for OBC category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC & ST applicants. The preference will be given to students who have appeared for the SU-JEE (Sandip University Joint Entrance Examination) or CLAT examination.

🎓 LL.B. (Hons) - 3 Years

The candidate should secure minimum 45% percentage of marks in case of general category applicants, and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants in any Graduation from the approved University.

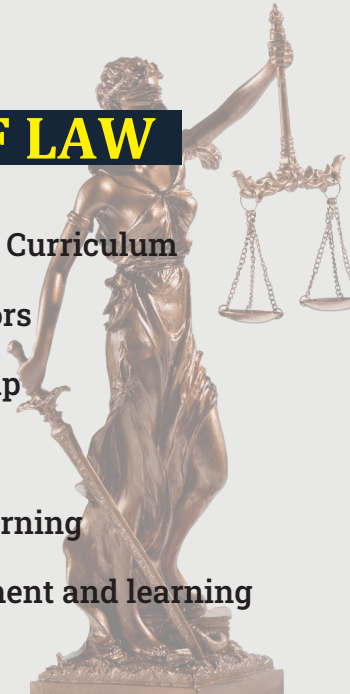

School of law organizes the Legal Fest "Lex spective", with the aim to provide the students with best of best opportunities to interact and learn with the esteemed experts of various fields .



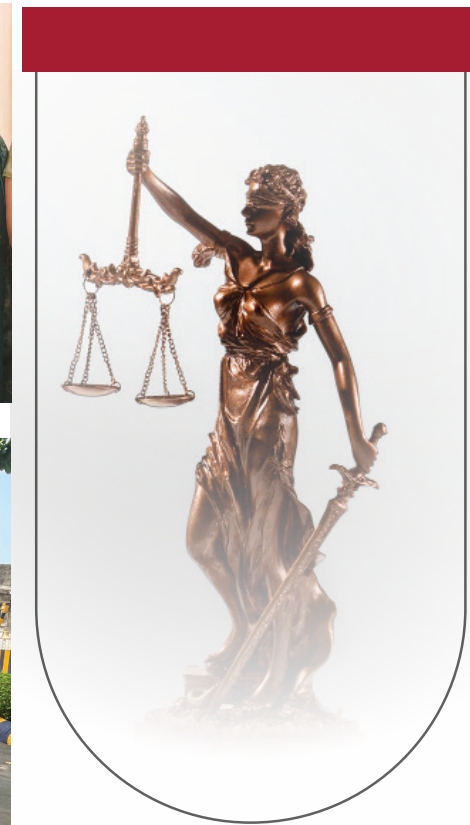
CSI Competition

School of Law hosted the Crime scene investigation competition.

The Objective of the event was inculcating practical, where any offence is committed, the subject matter of any criminal proceeding and thus this competition is arranged for our students to learn more about the circumstances surrounding a crime by using physical evidence from the crime scene and use of inductive and deductive reasoning to analyse the circumstantial evidences and facts. It is multidisciplinary competition and involves a systematic search of the crime scene with meticulous observation and documentation of the scene; photography and sketching; the identification, processing, and analysis of physical evidence such as footprints, blood, hair, fibres, biological fluids, other evidence; and perhaps the most important, the application of observational skills and reasoning capacity by participants.
