She also emphasized upon the need on the part of the government to use the provisions of compulsory licensing in order to bring the essential life saving drugs within the reach of common men.

She also brought about the threat of genetically modified crops on the fertility of the land. She stressed upon taking recourse to “Access and Benefit Sharing” provisions in order to protect the traditional knowledge of indigenous community.
