- vi. Display of art gallery of drawing & sketches: The art gallery featuring the drawings and sketches submitted by the participants is displayed for the audience. The gallery provides an opportunity for the audience to appreciate the creativity and talent of the participants.
- vii. Judgment of winners: The judges evaluate the entries and select the winners of the competition. The winners are announced, and the prizes are distributed.
- viii. Vote of thanks: The organizers thank the participants, guests and judges for their support and participation in the event. The vote of thanks marks the end of the event.
