The eminent speaker was **Dr.** Arun Kumar Dwivedi, Professor & Director IQAC, Sandip University, Nashik. **Dr.** Mahendra Shinde sir felicitated Dr. Arun Kumar Dwivedi sir and requested to continue the session.

Dr. Arun Kumar Dwivedi sir explained the relationships between education and employment are determined not only by the function of education to prepare learning for subsequent work tasks and other life spheres, but also by the fact that education selects. Further he continued that the education dissociates the learner physically from work in order to prepare in a rational way for coping with diversity of work and life tasks. Education has a qualifying function and a status-distributive function for economy and society and is among various factors determining graduates' careers.

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
Felicitation of Dr. Dwivedi sir by Dr .Mahendra Shinde sir, HOD of F.E. B.Tech.
