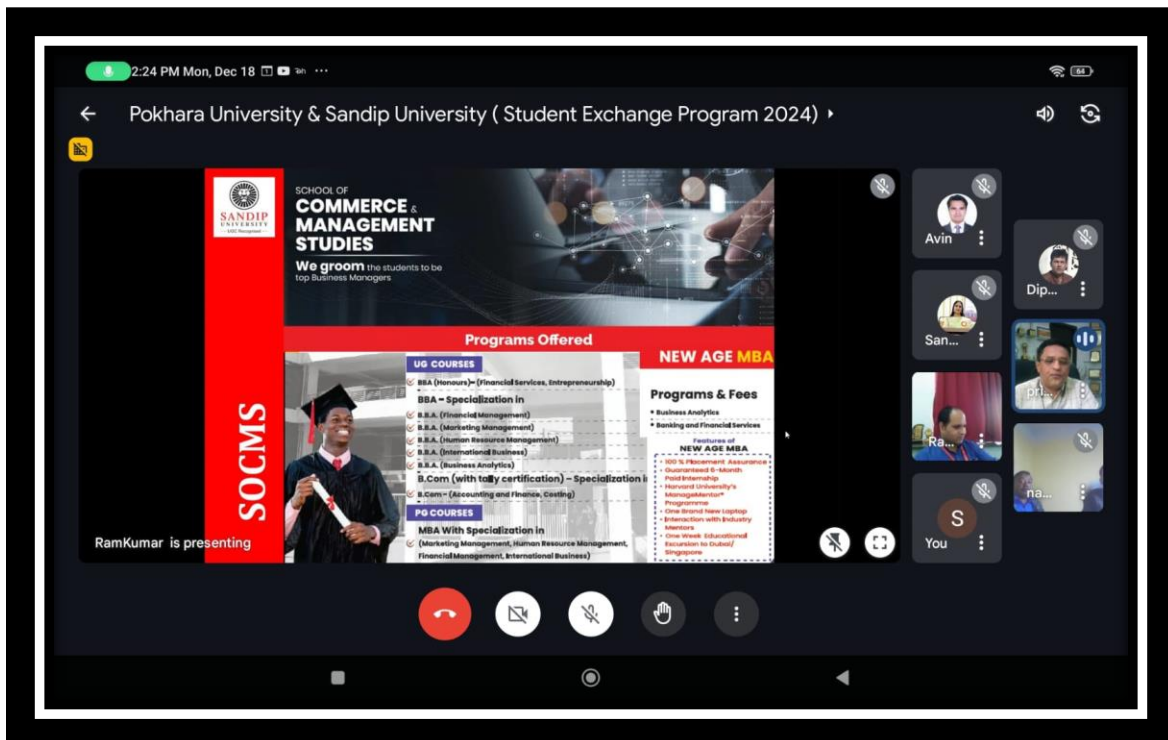
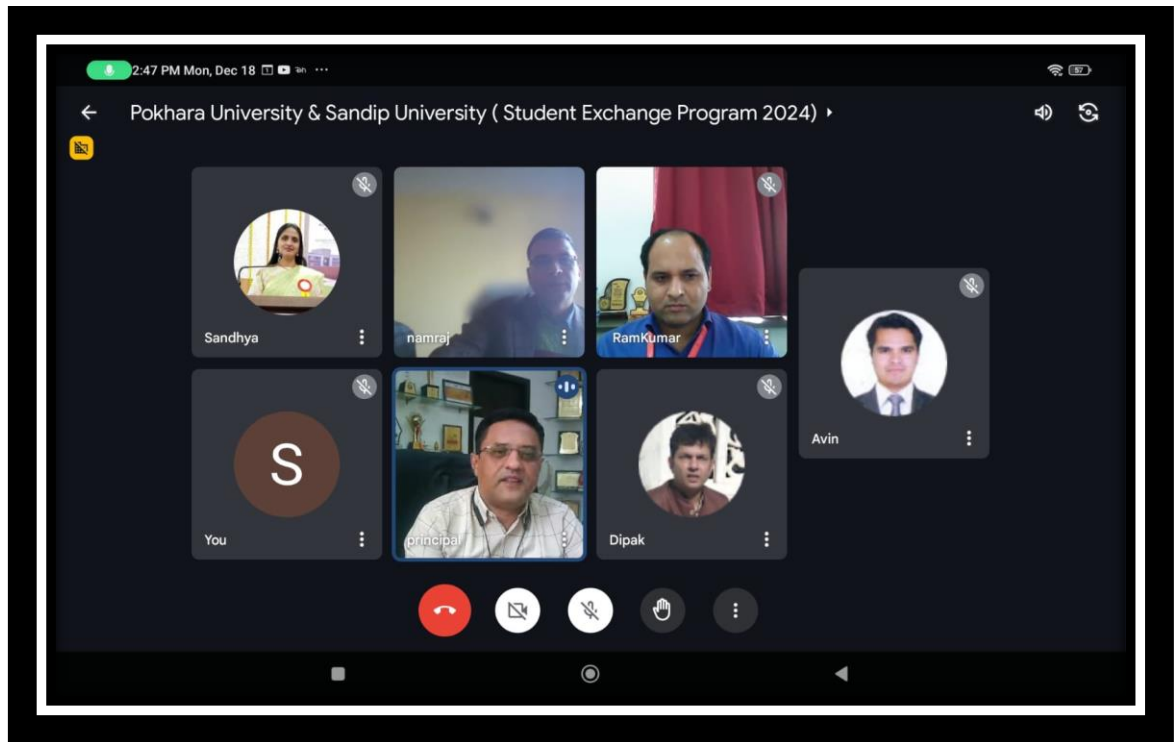
5. Collaborative Research Projects:
