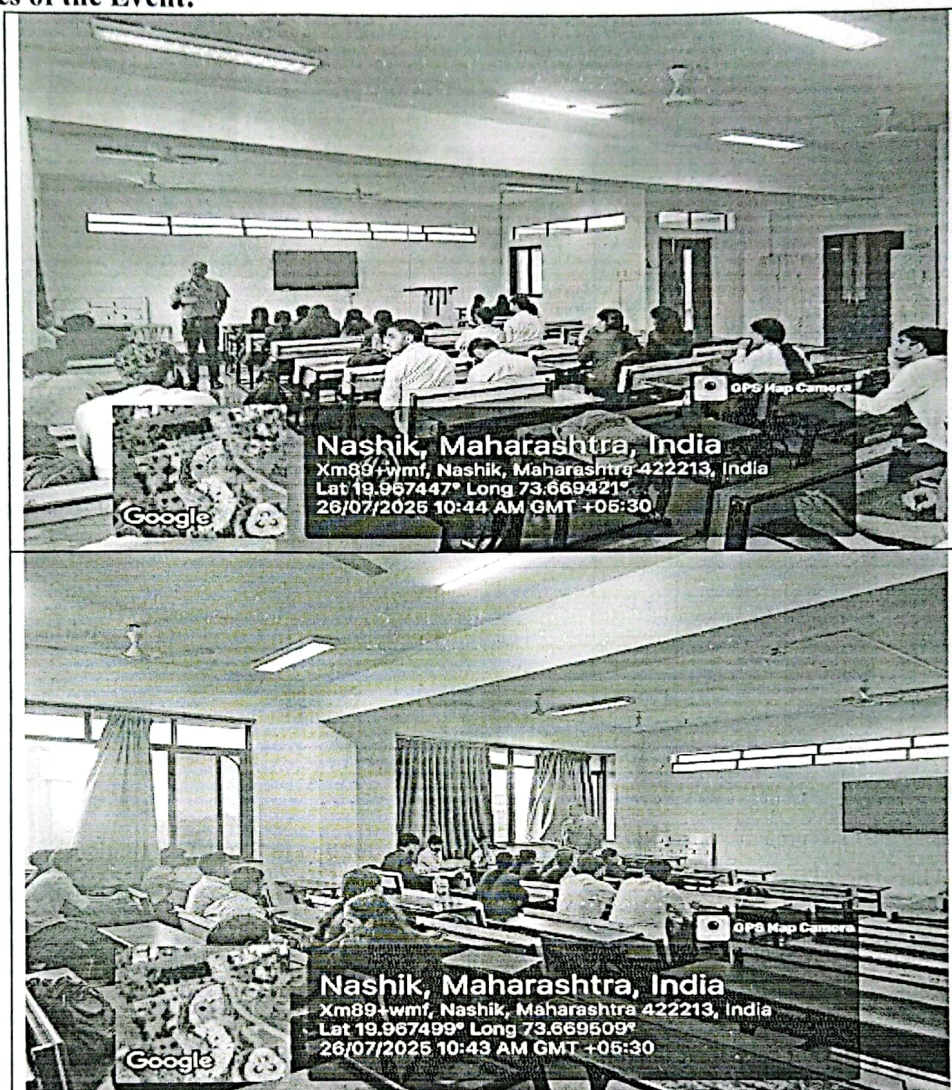
Outcome: Students gained valuable insights into career planning and were better prepared for upcoming placement drives. The program fostered confidence and readiness to transition into professional roles.
