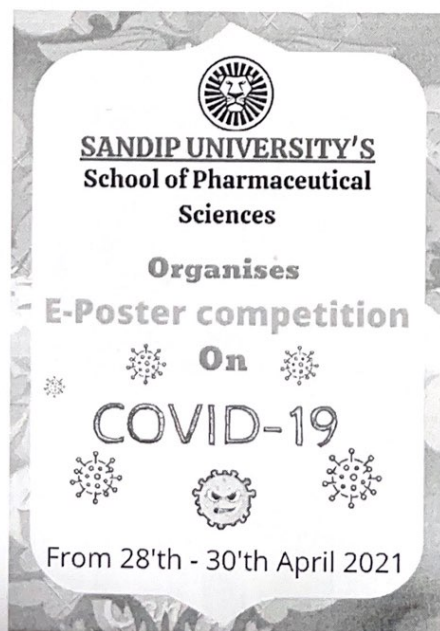
Event Outline & Outcome of the event:
