**Purpose of Visit**: To understand Medico-legal Procedure & gain practical knowledge of Autopsy.



A visit to Civil Hospital, Nashik was organized from 27/03/2025 to 11/04/2025 for F.Y. M.Sc., T.Y. B.Sc. and S.Y. B.Sc. Students of Dept. of Forensic Science, School of Science, Sandip University Nashik. It was an educational visit and an informative and practical session to provide practical exposure to real-life medico-legal and forensic procedures. Each day focused on a specific aspect of forensic science, tailored to the academic level of the attending batch. The visit aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and practical application, enhance observational skills, and deepen students' understanding of forensic pathology, toxicology, and medico-legal documentation through guided sessions, live case demonstrations, and expert interactions.

### **Brief Overview of Cyber Police Station**

Civil Hospital Nashik is one of the largest government-run healthcare institutions in North Maharashtra, offering comprehensive medical services including emergency care, outpatient and inpatient services, and specialized treatments across various departments and is affiliated with the Government Medical College, Nashik. The Forensic Medicine Department at Civil Hospital Nashik plays a pivotal role in medico-legal investigations, offering services such as post-mortem examinations, injury assessments, and toxicological analyses. The department collaborates closely with law enforcement and judicial bodies to ensure accurate and timely forensic evaluations, contributing significantly to the region's criminal justice system.

## **Key Highlights of the Visit**

During the visit, students were introduced to several important aspects of the work carried out by the Civil Hospital Staff:

- Real-time observation of post-mortem in a suspected cardiac death.
- Learning external and internal examination techniques.
- Understanding natural vs. suspicious death indicators.
- Observation of blunt force and sharp force injuries.
- Differentiating between homicidal, accidental, and suicidal injuries.
- Analysis of ligature marks, petechiae, and froth at nostrils.



• Training on viscera collection, preservation, and labelling.

The 15-day rotational visit to Civil Hospital Nashik proved to be an immensely enriching and educational experience for all participating batches of B.Sc. and M.Sc. Forensic Science students. Each day's visit was designed to provide focused, hands-on exposure to real medico-legal cases tailored to the academic level of the respective batch.

One of the most valuable aspects of the visit was the daily lectures delivered by experienced doctors and forensic experts. These sessions covered a wide range of critical topics such as post-mortem procedures, injury analysis, poisoning, forensic toxicology, asphyxial deaths, and sexual assault examination protocols. These interactive lectures helped bridge theoretical knowledge with practical application and encouraged critical thinking, discussion, and student engagement.
