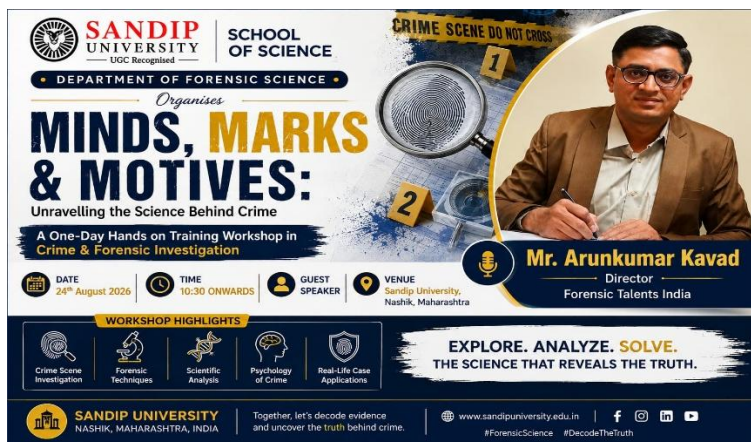
Objective of the Event:
