Brief description of Event:

The School of Science, Sandip University organized a Parents-Teacher Meet in September 2026 to strengthen communication and collaboration between parents, teachers and the institution. The meeting provided an important platform for discussing students' academic progress, attendance, classroom participation, discipline, co-curricular involvement and overall development. The event was organized with the understanding that the effective development of students requires continuous cooperation between the student, parent, faculty member and institution. Objective of the Event:

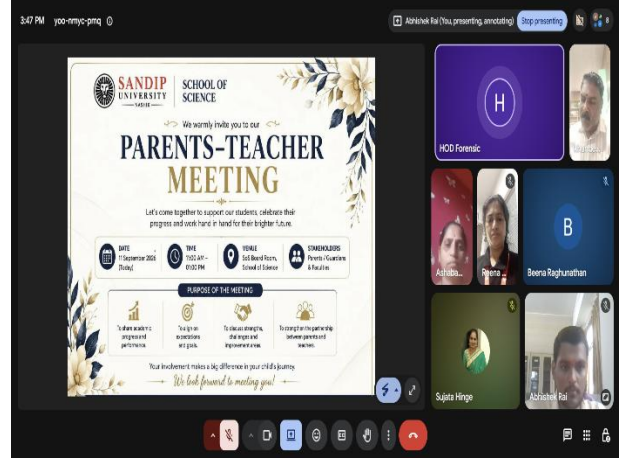
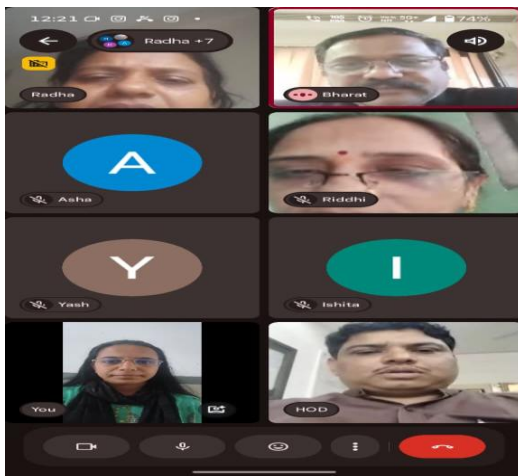
1. To establish effective communication between parents and teachers.
