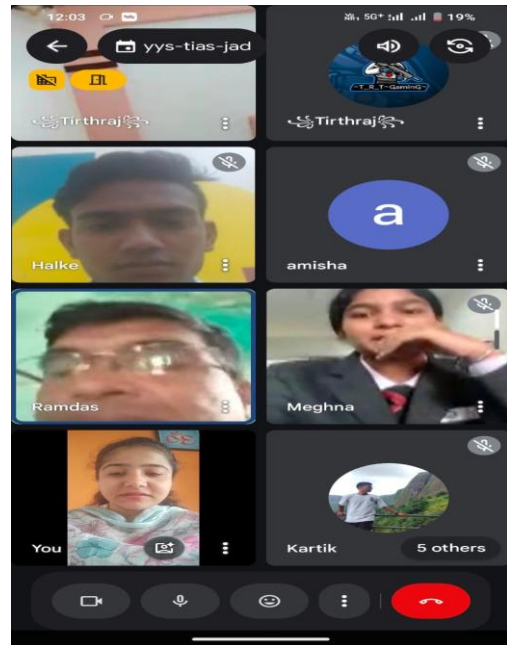
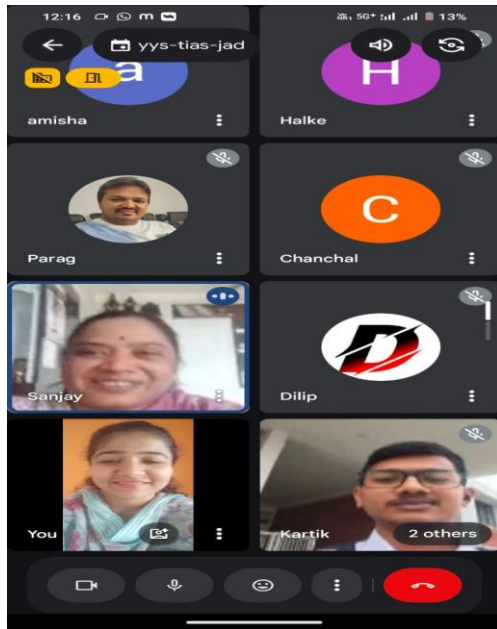
Report:
