### **ACADEMIC VISIT REPORT**

**Department /School Name : Department of Forensic Science (SOS)**

**Activity Title : Visit to Narcotics Control Bureau Gujarat**

**Activity Schedule : 09/02/2025 to 10/02/2025**

**Duration in Days : Two Days**

**Mode of Conduction : Off line**

An academic tour was organized for the Third Year B.Sc. Forensic Science students by the Department of Forensic Science, School of Science, Sandip University, Nashik, to Ahmedabad, Gujarat, on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025. The objective of the tour was to provide students with practical exposure to forensic science applications by visiting reputed forensic laboratories and law enforcement agencies.

The trip was coordinated by Ms. Nidhi Pandya (Assistant Professor) and accompanied by Mr. Indranil Suryawanshi (Assistant Professor), Ms. Sudeshna Bag (Assistant Professor), and Mr. Ekanath Patil (Technical Assistant). A total of 32 students participated in the visit.

The journey commenced from Sandip University, Nashik, on 8th February 2025 at 8:30 PM. The students and faculty members traveled overnight and reached Ahmedabad by 11:00 AM on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2025. On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2025, the students visited at Forensic Talents India Pvt. Ltd., Ahmedabad, a leading forensic laboratory in India. The students were welcomed by Mr. Arun Kavadi, Founder of Forensic Talents India Pvt. Ltd., along with his team. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed between Forensic Talents India Pvt. Ltd. and the Department of Forensic Science, Sandip University, Nashik, to facilitate future collaborations, internships, and research opportunities.

Mr. Arun Kavadi and his team interacted with students, discussing various aspects of forensic science, laboratory operations, and emerging trends in forensic investigations. The team demonstrated forensic kits used for different forensic examinations and provided insights into their applications.

On 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025, the students visited the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) Zonal Unit, Ahmedabad, where they were introduced to the functions and responsibilities of the NCB in tackling drug-related crimes. The students were warmly welcomed by Inspector Parikh and his team. Inspector Parikh provided a detailed briefing on the role and activities of NCB, emphasizing the importance of drug enforcement and its legal framework. The session included awareness on drug abuse and its impact on society, along with real-life case studies handled by NCB. The officers demonstrated the techniques used in narcotics detection and investigation, including drug identification methods and controlled deliveries. The students gained valuable knowledge about the collaboration between forensic science and law enforcement agencies in combating drug-related crimes. The visit to the NCB Zonal Unit provided students with a law enforcement perspective on forensic applications, allowing them to understand the role of forensic science in drug-related investigations.
