The villagers actively participated in the programme and appreciated the initiative taken by the university. Their involvement added value to the programme and strengthened community bonding.

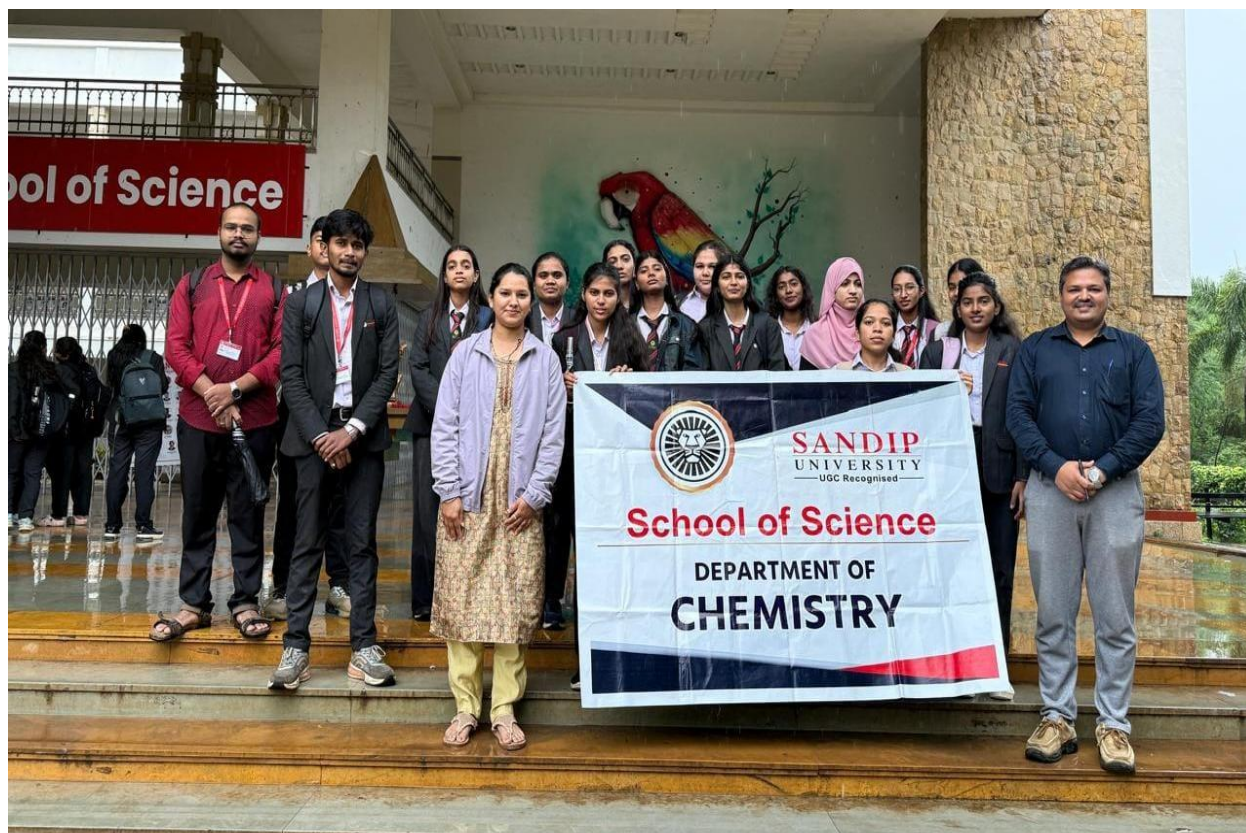
## **4. Hands-on Learning Experience**

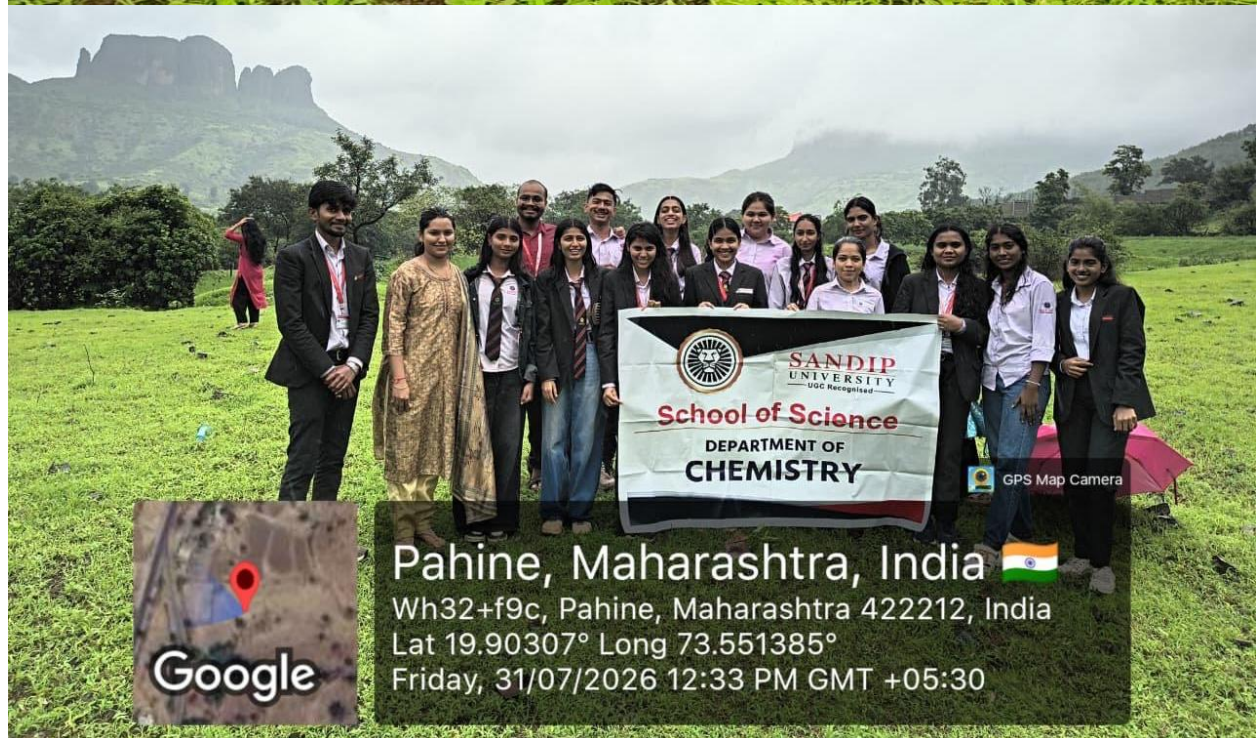
Students gained practical exposure through plantation activities and interaction with the local community, enhancing their understanding of real-world environmental challenges.
