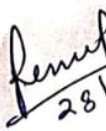

Objective of the Event:

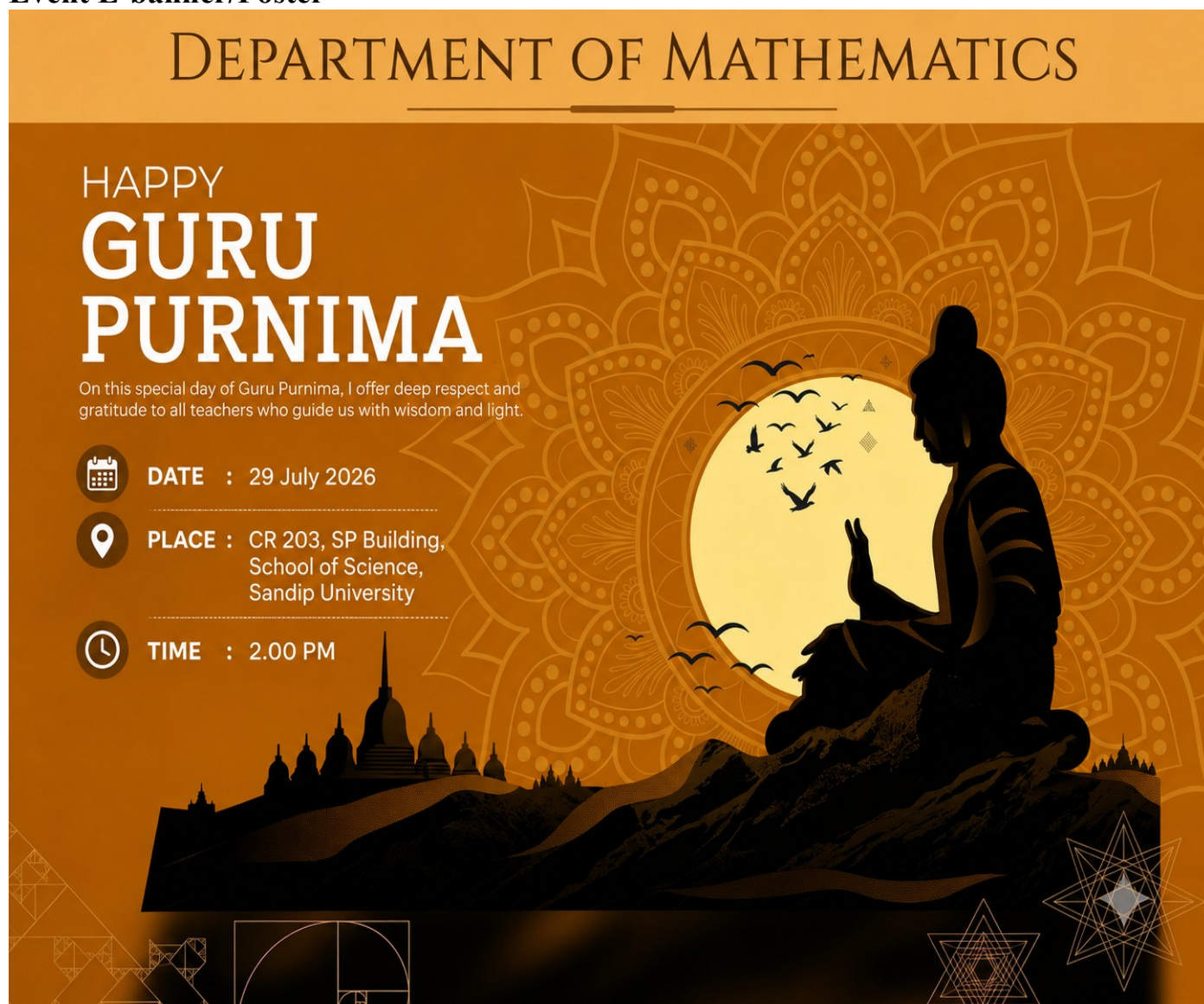
- To celebrate **Guru Purnima** and acknowledge the invaluable contribution of teachers in shaping students' academic and personal lives.
