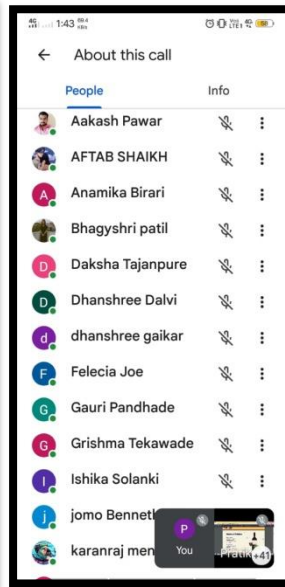
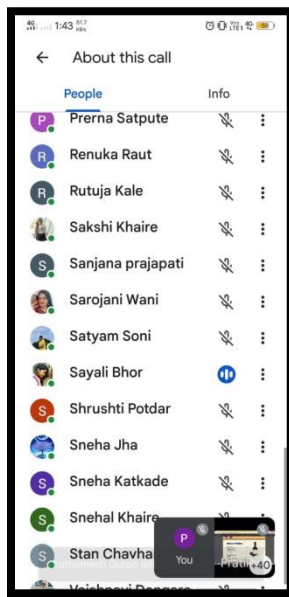
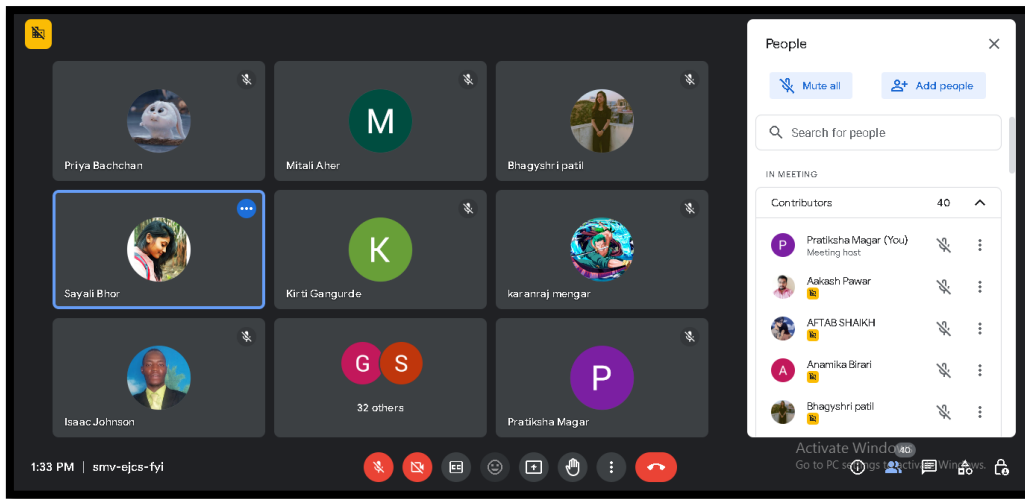
Objective:
