About the Program:

Seminar Overview: Decoding the Dynamics of Interview Analysis

In our organised programmes, interviews are typically dissected solely based on the content of the conversation. However, this conventional approach tends to attribute each statement to individual speakers, overlooking the dynamic and collaborative nature of a conversation. This seminar aims to shift this perspective, exploring interviews as dynamic events rather than isolated content.

Understanding the Interactional Constitution: We challenge the notion that interviews can be understood solely by analysing individual statements. Instead, we emphasise the interactional constitution of interviews, viewing them as processes shaped collaboratively by participants. The content emerges from interactions, creating a situation where participants provide each other with the resources needed to navigate the unfolding conversation.

Irreducibility in Participants and Time. The nature of interviews is irreducible, concerning both participants and time. Individual lines cannot be cleanly attributed to specific individuals, highlighting the collaborative effort in the conversation. Similarly, the temporal aspect is crucial, as participants may not foresee the conversation's trajectory, leading to an evolving understanding throughout.
